

# Frequently Asked Questions

Why does my hydrant disappear after I enter information in the Popup to adopt it?

You need to refresh the page in your web browser.

What if I close the popup after choosing adopt, but before entering my name and email?

Only the check and clean dates can be changed after adoption.

You can also add pictures of your hydrant.

What if I close the popup after entering information and refresh the page but my hydrant symbol doesn't change color, to yellow indicating adopted?

You may have forgotten to change the top field value from "available for adoption" to "adopted". You can click the adopt a hydrant button top left and then click your hydrant again to set the first field to adopted. Make sure the other fields are filled in before closing the popup again.
